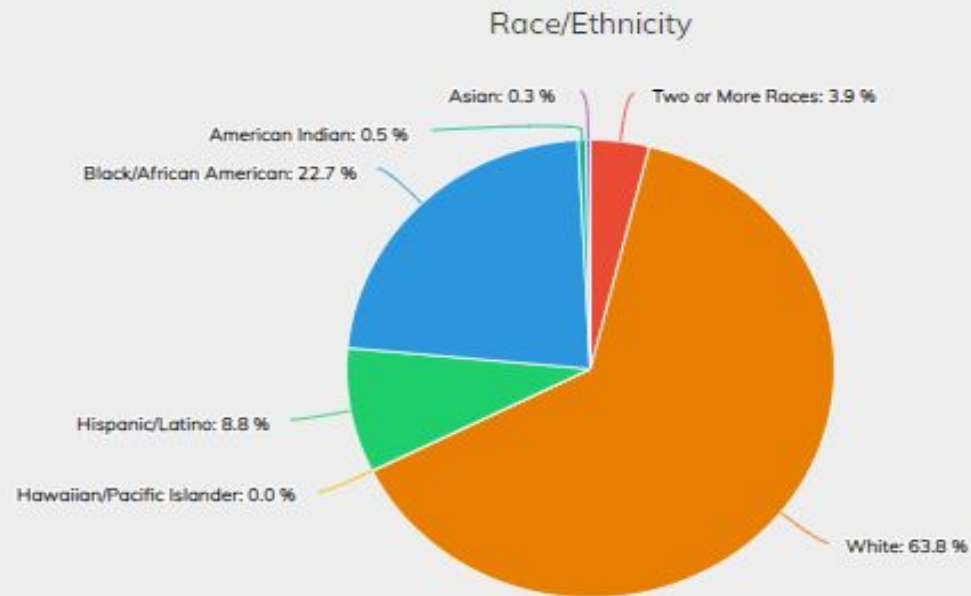

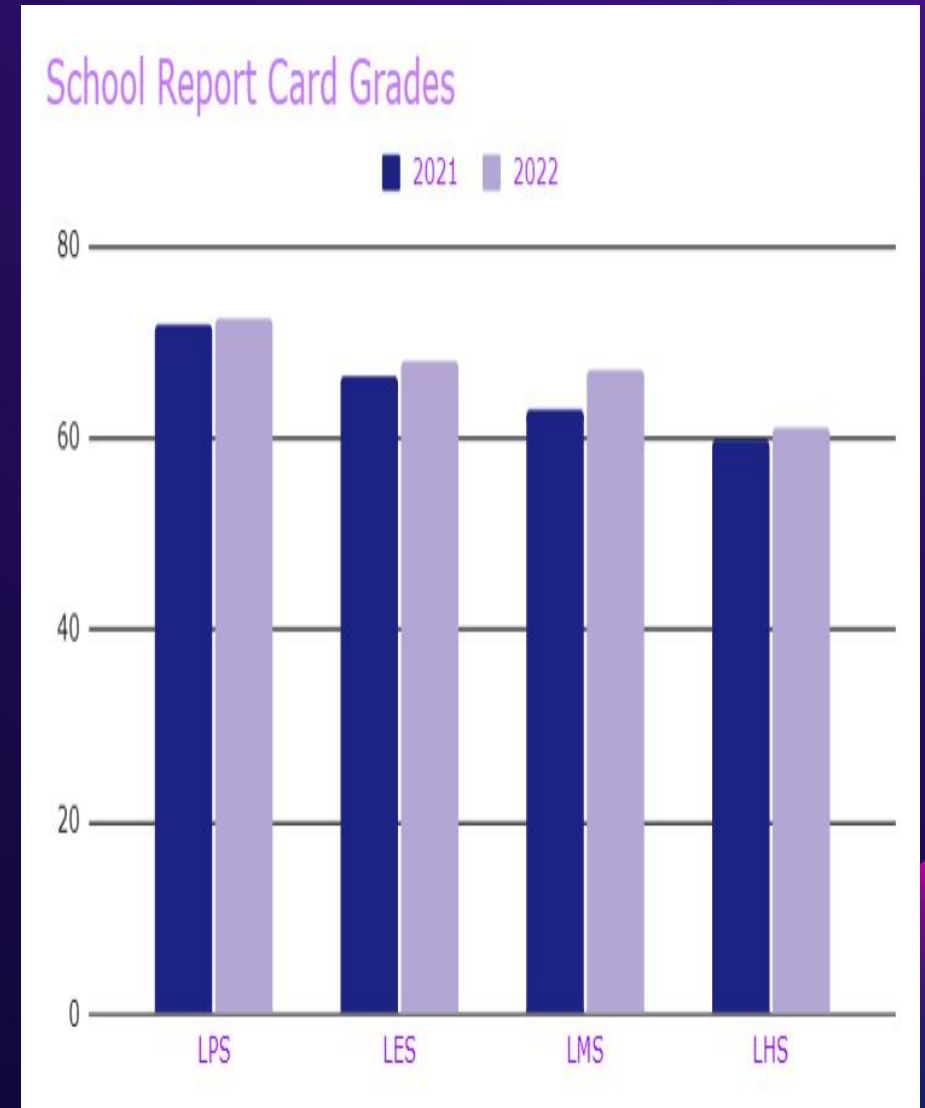

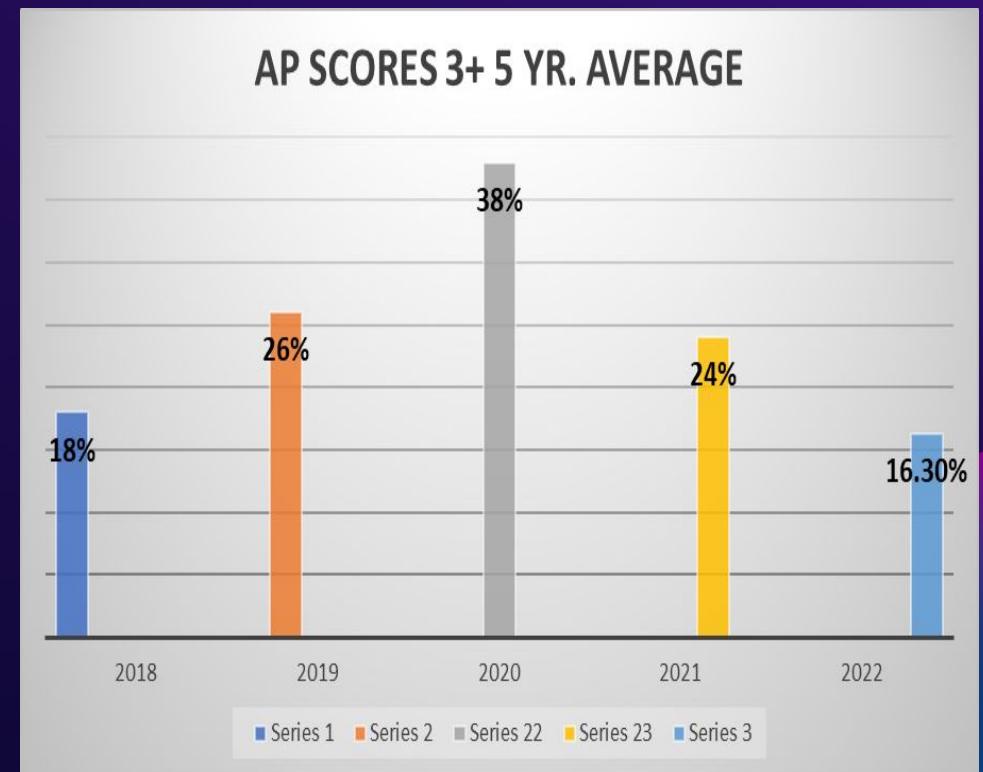

2021 Four Year Graduation Rates - All Students

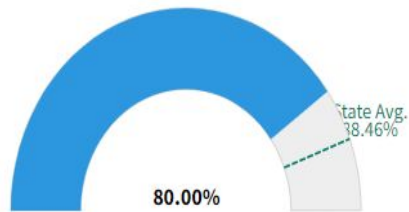

2021 Five Year Graduation Rates - All Students

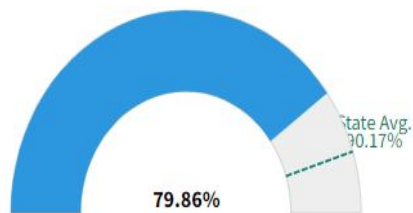
