We are delighted to announce the reopening of the Baptist Health Lonoke School Clinic, in a brand new building behind the high school safe room. Dr. Alicia Asbury, a pediatrician, has joined our staff and will be working in the school clinic to serve the needs of the students. We are committed to making a concerted effort to improve the health of the students by performing comprehensive yearly wellness exams. If your child already has a primary care physician (PCP), please schedule an appointment with their office to have the wellness exam completed. We desire to support and supplement the care of your primary care physician. If your child does not have a PCP, we will be able to schedule their wellness exam. The wellness exam will also qualify for their activities/sports physical, if needed. We will be having a well clinic and a sick clinic, as needed. Our desire is to keep the sick and well children separate, thus we will schedule appointments. Everyone will have a temperature screen and COVID questions on entrance. Masks need to be worn in the clinic. If you do not have one, one will be supplied.

As of now, we do not have the ability to test for COVID.

If your child does not have health insurance, please contact us for additional options.

Please call 676-7089 to schedule a time to have your child's wellness exam performed and get prepared for a new school year and activities. Calls will be accepted 7:30-4:30 Monday- Friday. We will need signed consent prior to the appointment. We can discuss the easiest way to move forward with this when scheduling the appointment.
