



LPSD Plan for Athletic Events

As Per ADH Directives

2020

Requirements

Face coverings must be worn throughout all games. Face coverings may be removed to consume food or beverages.

The public not to enter if they have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat or loss of taste or smell, and to refrain from entering if they are 65 years or older, have underlying health conditions including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, severe obesity, asthma, or weakened immunity.

Seating, Tickets

1. The number of tickets for home/visiting team(s) will be determined by seating capacity, which will be determined by social distancing guidelines (every other bleacher/row, 6 ft. apart).
2. Tickets will be pre-sold to families first (players, band, and cheer-dance). An allotment will be given to visiting teams, which will be sold and distributed by their staff.
 - a. Any remaining tickets will be sold at the Home Gate.
3. Entrances, exits, concessions, restrooms, etc. will be identified with visual cues to ensure social distancing (6 ft.).
4. Total Football Stadium Capacity will be capped at 505
 - a. 405 Home
 - b. 100 Visitor

Admittance and Gate

1. All students in grades K-8 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or a responsible adult to supervise their students to ensure compliance with ADH guidelines.
2. All fans must remain in the stadium/gym throughout the contests. There will be no re-admittance to an event once fans leave the competition area.
3. Face coverings are required for admittance to events. No mask, no admittance.

Facilities: Stadium and Gymnasium

1. Bleacher/gymnasium seating will be restricted so that every other row is unoccupied.
2. Signage indicating social distancing will be placed around fencing in the football stadium to ensure compliance with the 6 ft. requirement.
3. Restrooms and frequently touched surfaces will be disinfected as needed.

Concessions:

1. All items will be pre-packaged.
2. Visual cues will be used to ensure social distancing.

Supervision of Events

1. Administrators will monitor events for compliance with ADH directives.
2. When it becomes necessary, administrators will address any non-compliant behavior with reminders or recommendations to watch events through live streaming on our athletic website.
