On Saturday, September 12, 2020, the Lonoke Public School District learned that a student at Lonoke Elementary School tested positive for COVID-19. As a result, nine other students were quarantined.

On Tuesday, September 15, 2020, the District was informed that a student at Lonoke High School tested positive for COVID-19. As a result, 41 additional students were quarantined along with two coaches and four teachers.

Twenty-five of the quarantined students are on the high school volleyball team, therefore, all volleyball games during the quarantine time frame (9/15/20 through 9/29/20) will be cancelled or rescheduled. As per AAA policy, games that cannot be rescheduled will be considered "No Contest" games and will not be counted against the school's program.

The District has informed the ADH and ADE and has followed all specified guidance and directives in terms of case reporting and quarantining.
