It is the goal of LPSD to form a partnership among the school, parents, students, and community. The following is an outline of what our goals for this partnership are:

1. Have a jointly-developed Family Community Engagement Plan, which can be found in the schools, on our website, and in the student handbook.
2. Host regular PIE meetings at the schools, and at time when convenient for parents.
3. Have shared communication among teachers, staff, and students with newsletters, social media, etc. This communication will be in multiple languages when necessary.
4. Set aside 1% of our Title I Funding to FCE at the local level.
5. Provide assistance to parents in how to help students succeed on Arkansas State Standards and the state summative assessment (ACT Aspire.)
6. Host opportunities for family engagement at the schools throughout the year (Trunk or Treat, District Meetings, Winter Carnivals, Financial Aid Nights, FYI Night, Sweetheart Supper, fundraisers, Art Exhibitions, Art and Literacy Night, and Parent University).
7. Host two Parent Teacher Conferences each school year.
8. Have a jointly-developed Title I Parent Compact.
